Facility Closures, Limited Permit Center Services and Parking Enforcement

Salinas, CA -- With the Shelter in Place order in effect, staff are remaining at home for the health and safety of the community and their families. All City facilities remain closed to the public. Minimal Permit Center staff is available to issue emergency permits and schedule inspections during the closure. Additionally, during the Shelter in Place order, parking enforcement operations that support essential services or health and safety will continue. However, due to limited services and community impacts of COVID-19, the City will not enforce abandoned vehicles, parking over 72-hours, street sweeping zones, and 2-hour parking zones in Residential Parking District 3A (area surrounding Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital).

Parking citations may be issued for the following violations:

- Red Zones
- Green Zones
- City Parking Lots
- Parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant
- Oversize Vehicles
